


How to Open a Hyperion v8.3 Saved Query in v11.1.2.1

NOTE: Due to Hyperion v8.3 being “shut down”, these instructions are being revised.

Agencies, who have installed Internet Explorer version 7 and higher, must use the “Drag & Drop Method”.

TO DO THIS:


- 1) Go to where your saved query is in Windows Explore so you can see your Desktop and all your hard drives you have access to.



- 2) Minimize its window.

You can do this one of two ways:

1. In the upper right hand corner of your screen, click the middle icon button. When you hover over this middle icon you will see “Restore Down”.




2. Alternatively, you can double-click on the heavy blue line or the top line of your screen (this is a toggle – double-clicking this line will minimize and maximize your screen)




- 3) Get to Hyperion v11.1.2.1 Login page and “Restore Down” its window. You should now have two open windows showing.

- 4) Then drag/drop your saved query into the open Hyperion v11.1.2.1 session window to open it up.



- 5) You will get the Hyperion v8.3 login, so click the “X” in the upper right hand corner to close this window.



How to Open a Hyperion v8.3 Saved Query in v11.1.2.1

- 6) Click the OK button when you get this pop-up window.
(NOTE: Not all users may get this pop-up window.)



- 7) Click the OK button when you get this pop-up window.



- 8) When you get the Connect to Server pop-up window:
- You will see the old Server Address.
 - Highlight the old Server Address and click the Delete button on your keyboard.
 - Then copy/paste the below URL for saved queried in the Server Address box:

 - Then click the Connect button.

- 9) You will get the Hyperion v11.1.2.1 login screen, so login using your FPPS (aka RACF) user ID and 8-character password.




10) Your saved query will then open up in v11.1.2.1.

To ensure you are in the correct Hyperion version:

- Go up to Help on the menu bar
- From its drop down window, select “About Hyperion Interactive Reporting Web Client...”



11) Here is where you will see the Hyperion version your saved query opened up in.




How to Open a Hyperion v8.3 Saved Query in v11.1.2.1

The below “**Convert BQY File**” window is not a problem. However, if you get this pop-up window trying to open up a saved query, click the **OK button**.



If you click the Cancel button, you will get:



Solution(s):

- User needs to click the **OK button**. If user does not want to see this pop-up window every time try to get into the query, needs to check the box next to:
 Use this choice for all subsequent documents opened and do not show this dialog.
- If an Agency publisher (aka Content publisher) saves a Hyperion v8.3 query, and then Publishes it in Hyperion v11.1.2.1, when he/she tries to run the published query in v11.1.2.1, will get this “**Convert BQY File**” pop-up window. This is a valid pop-up window. To avoid getting this “Convert BQY File” pop-up window, instead of saving the query from v8.3, save it from v11.1.2.1.
