Enabled by NASA's Human Capital Information Environment (HCIE), NASA has launched a redesigned and upgraded **NASAPeople** website, one of NASA's public facing sites providing critical information to NASA's job seekers, alumni, and the public. The new NASAPeople provides these groups information about jobs at NASA, working for NASA, benefits, retiree-related data, and much more. The site also presents information on Federal and NASA human resource-related policies and regulations, and provides logistics information, including a map of all of the NASA centers.
